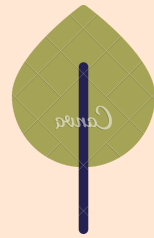

SNAICC is a national non-governmental peak body in Australia representing the interests of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children

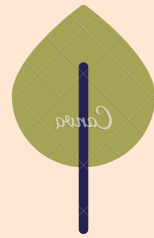

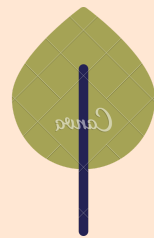

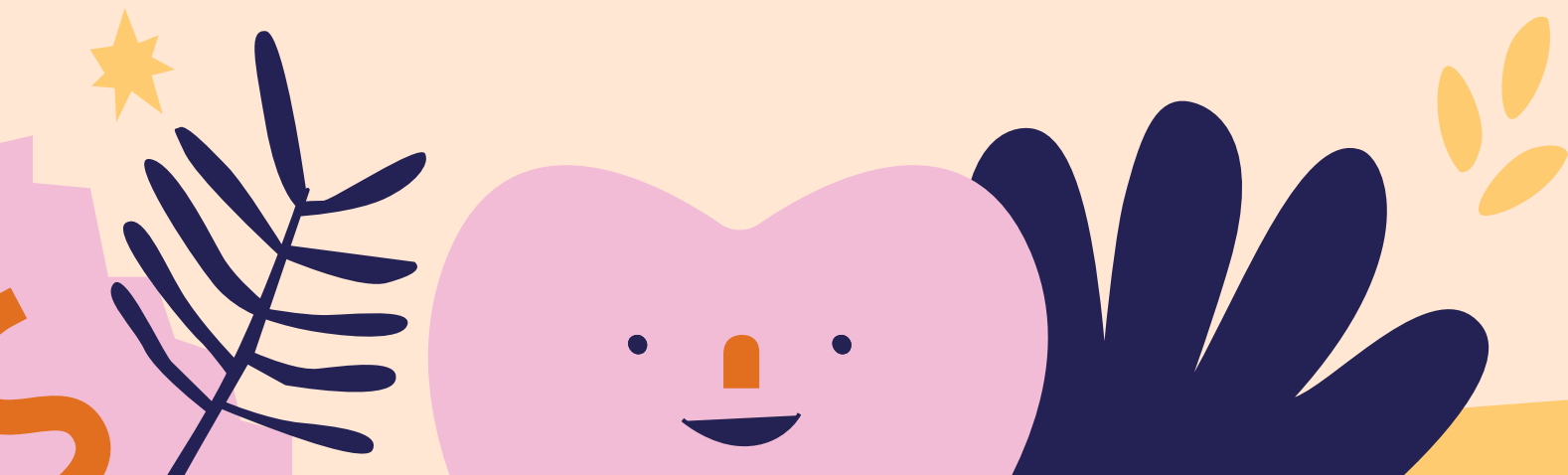
